Next Steps for Undergraduate Students

Congratulations on your offer to join us at the John H. Daniels Faculty of Architecture, Landscape, and Design for September 2016. Please review the information below as you prepare for your first year at UofT.

Your Offer

If you have not already done so, please follow the instructions included in your admission package to accept your offer of admission by the stated deadline. Check the [Join UofT Portal](#) for your admission information.

Your Accommodation

If you have requested housing and are offered a place in a residence, your offer will be sent via email directly from the residence. Make sure you accept your residence offer and pay your deposit by the stated deadlines. Fall session move-in days are **September 4 & 5**. If you have any questions about your residence offer or would like assistance with your off campus housing search, [UofT Student Housing Services](#) will be able to assist you.

Your Academics

Join us for the Summer Welcome Event & Academic Orientation on **Saturday, June 25**. This session is a great opportunity to learn more about degree requirements, how course selection works, what you can expect in your first year of study, and will give you the opportunity to ask questions and to meet faculty, student services staff, and other students. Further event information will be posted on our [website](#) in June. If you cannot attend the Summer Welcome Event & Academic Orientation, you will find detailed information from the session on our website by July 1.

Over the coming weeks you should take some time to familiarize yourself with UofT's online registration and records system, [ACORN](#) (also called the "Student Web Service"). All course enrolment takes place online. Students admitted into first year will begin course enrolment on **Thursday, July 28**. It is a good idea to log on to ACORN and choose your courses as soon as your enrolment window begins.

Transfer students admitted into second year begin course enrolment on **Thursday, July 21**. Students who wish to apply for transfer credits should review the information and deadlines on our [website](#).

Fall classes will begin **Monday, September 12**.

Your Finances

If you are an Ontario resident looking for a government loan, start early and apply for the [Ontario Student Assistance Plan \(OSAP\)](#) in order to ensure that you receive a response prior to September. If you are from out of province, check with your local funding agency about relevant deadlines. If you are not eligible for government aid, take the time to plan all your expenses and set a budget to ensure you have adequate funding available for the upcoming year.

You can view your student fees through ACORN. The first installment of your academic tuition fee is due by **Tuesday, August 23**. Fee deferral requests must also be submitted through ACORN by this date. To find out if you are eligible to defer your fees, please visit the [student accounts website](#).

If you have accepted an offer to residence, be sure to pay the minimum fees installment that is listed in your residence letter by the stated deadline.

Your Student Life

Prior to the beginning of the Fall term you will need to obtain your [UofT student card \(TCard\)](#), activate your [UTORID](#), and begin using your [UofT email account](#). Please make sure your email settings accept emails and attachments from addresses with 'daniels.utoronto.ca' and 'utoronto.ca' domains (check your 'junk' box regularly just in case). Your UofT email is your official email account and important information will be sent here.
